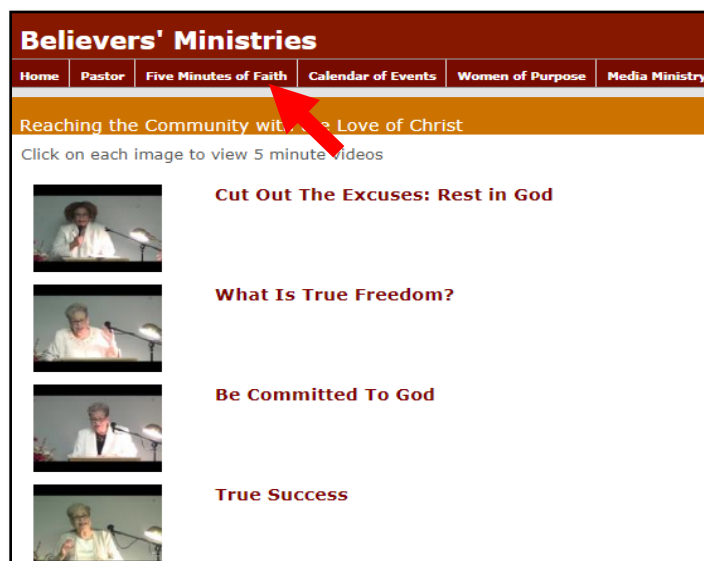


Five Minutes of Faith

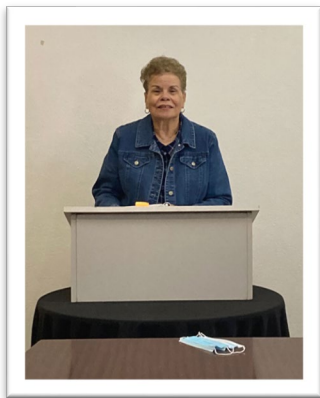
Tecumseh Outdoor Drama, Chillicothe, Ohio

58th Wedding Anniversary



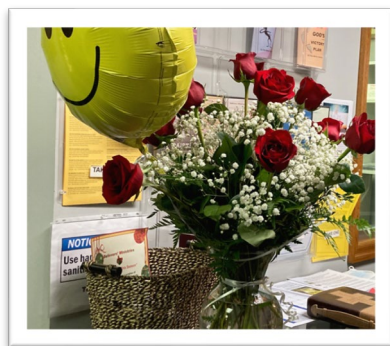

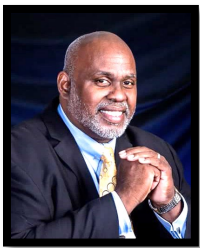


Donations to Faith Mission and American Red Cross
